1. Electric Forester's unique Electromagnetic Radiation (EMR) Advice Line provides the first c.10 minutes of professional investigator consultation FREE of Charge.
2. Callers are required to provide an e-mail or postal address for receipt of these Terms & Conditions.
3. At some future date Electric Forester may wish to provide callers with additional information directly or indirectly related to their enquiry. Should you wish not to receive such communications, please advise the consultant accordingly. We will not 'spam' you.
4. For the avoidance of doubt, no contract exists between Electric Forester Investigations Ltd. and enquirers to the EMR Advice Line for the first c.10 minutes, until payment terms have been agreed.
5. Enquiries can include any aspect of EMR and general or specific questions on one or more topics or property addresses. Enquirers can ask any question they wish. Should during the course of the first FREE 10 minutes it become clear that the scope of the enquiry requires more time or follow-up then enquirers will be invited to discuss whether a charge would be fair.
6. In any event, after c.10 minutes the consultant will request agreement on method of payment at Electric Forester's Standard Advice Line rate (£0.60p/minute for the call duration, less the initial FREE 10 minutes).
7. Enquirers will be advised the duration and charge before the end of the call.

EMR Levels and Exposure Hazards:
